

The ICT enabled Teaching-learning Process

The Institute has policy and mechanism in place for promoting application of Information and Communication Technology for effective curriculum delivery. To support it Teaching-Learning resources provided are adequate and ICT compatible.

Computer Labs: The College has fully functional and well equipped computer labs for imparting Mathematics, Computer Science and Information Technology programmes. The college has functional Language Lab for the students enrolled for language programmes.

The Library of the College gives an access to the learners and teachers to Computers for academic purposes. It also provides access to the internet data base of research contents for academic purposes. The college has subscribed N-List (E-Journals E Books). The Library is partially automated with Integrated Library Management System- ILMS E-Granthalaya. The departments are provided laptops, desktops, printers and LCD projectors.

The Classrooms are equipped with wall mounted LCD Monitors. The smart board and laptops are available on demand for teachers to use during teaching. The well-equipped seminar hall THM is available for accommodating large number of participants and for small groups of participants G-19 provides infrastructure for use of ICT technology.

The teachers use various educational technologies to support classroom teaching. In the year 2020-21 due to COVID-19 restrictions teachers mainly used online technology like **Google Meet, Zoom, and WebEx** for delivering regular lectures.

The college has subscribed the ZOOM application and provided for the classes with large number of students. For small classrooms the teachers used Google Meet or WebEx platforms. To supplement and promote the continuous internal evaluation the various department used KAHOOT software to conduct online quiz. Google Classrooms are used by the department to share the PPTs, videos, web links and online quizzes in Google form.

The online technology facilitated interactive methods for teaching learning process in which teachers motivated students to prepare and deliver presentations, seminars, debates, group discussion, assignments, quizzes and viva etc.
