


Skill enhancement through sharing of video on mask stitching

DLLE in association with Social Outreach Committee took initiative for sharing of content related to stitching skills online through simple videos to the ladies from the adopted Vasat village, Ambernath. One student from DLLE Ms Aastha Naik (FYBScCMiB) prepared simple videos showing different steps of mask making and blouse stitching. The videos were then sent to the Village sarpanch who then provided the videos to the village ladies. The video helped the ladies to understand the various steps of stitching of mask. To supplement the knowledge of stitching skills among the tribal ladies of Vasat village (who were given basic skills in stitching by social outreach and DLLE committee of the college) for the enhancement and employability. The ladies of the village were familiarized with the different steps stitching styles and techniques which helped them to plan and design different styles of masks. Sharing of such videos will help them to become self-reliant and further raise the economic opportunities available, with minimum access to formal education and training. 
