The Resource Person emphasized the following constitutional provisional for minorities.

- "Prohibition of discrimination against citizens on grounds of religion, race, caste, sex or place of birth"
- "Citizens' right to 'equality of opportunity in employment and prohibition of discrimination on grounds of religion, race, caste, sex or place of birth"
- "People's freedom of conscience and right to freely profess, practice and propagate religion subject to public order, morality and other Fundamental Rights"
- "Right of all religious and linguistic minorities to establish and administer educational institutions of their choice"
- "Freedom of minority-managed educational institutions from discrimination in the matter of receiving aid from the State"
  - At the end of the lecture, the resource person answered the questions raised by participants.

#### Abstract

Proved theorem serves as a building block of mathematics and helps in its advancement. To formulate a theorem and prove it beyond doubt has therefore been one of the core activities from antiquity.

With time, the proof of the theorem became intricate in the sense of its length. Over the last five decades some of the proofs assumed gigantic length and checking their correctness by age old manual method is found wanting. As a natural recourse, the use of computers was introduced in the theorem-proof process.

However, it has raised several questions. Does the machine understand the meaning of the theorem, can it establish a new theorem, can the hardware and software of a computer be assumed flawless are some of those.

The talk will focus on the changing trends in this context and reflect on the consequences.





#### STUDENTS' FORUM


