

## Policy on Anti-Ragging

### I: Background:

As per the Supreme Court Ruling (Civil Appeal No. 887 of 2009) and under Section 26 (1) (g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956) New Delhi, 110002, the 17<sup>th</sup> June 2009 (<https://www.ugc.ac.in/page/Ragging-Related-Circulars.aspx>), Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti- Ragging Squad are set up in Smt. Chandibai Himathmal Mansukhani College.

### II: Objectives:

1. To create awareness about harmful effects of ragging.
2. To prohibit occurrence of ragging in all forms from the college and maintain ragging free environment in the college campus.

### III: Measures for prevention of ragging at the institution level:

#### 1. Before admission:

- ▶ The Prospectus has undertaking regarding prohibition of ragging.
- ▶ The undertaking is filled and signed by the student making him/her aware of the law regarding prohibition of ragging as well as the punishments.
- ▶ College has separate notice board for anti-raging committee, where posters are displayed depicting dehumanizing effect of ragging.

#### 2) On admission:

- ▶ The College organizes sensitization and awareness programs for students against ragging.

### IV: Committee setup and functions:-

#### a. The Anti-Ragging Committee:

The College Anti-Ragging Committee is constituted according to UGC regulations. It monitors the anti- ragging activities in the institution.

#### b. The Anti-Ragging Squad:

The Anti-Ragging Squad is constituted according to UGC regulations. The Squad investigates incidents of ragging and has patrolling function.

### V: The mechanism for handling issues of ragging is as follows:

The information on ragging is received in the following manner:

1. Complaint is given through contact details displayed on Anti ragging notice board and also on national help-line number on ragging.

2. In the event of receipt of information/complaint of ragging, Anti-Ragging Committee and squad of the college promptly conducts an inquiry into the incident as per provisions laid down in Clause 6.3(e) of the UGC Regulations No.F.1-16/2009(CPP-II)
