

The program started at sharp 10 am with the National Anthem followed by Saraswati Vandana. The welcome address and opening remarks were given by the HOD of Chemistry, Dr. A. D. Tiwari. He spoke about the objectives of the Seminar: Sensitization towards the utility of Biopolymers for a Sustainable Ecofriendly Environment and Encouraging the scientific community towards the study of naturally occurring renewable materials to make bioplastics and allied materials. He also spoke about the expected outcome of creating an amongst the scientific community about the fast-emerging field of Biopolymer Science and its importance in reducing the world's dependency on non-renewable materials and





improving the quality of life. Then the Vice Principal, Science addressed all the participants. Although, Principal, Dr. Manju Lalwani Pathak could not grace the program due to her busy schedule, she conveyed her best wishes for the successful conduct of the program. The target audience were the Faculty Members, Ph.D. Students/ Research Scholars, PG & UG Learners of Chemistry. The online International Seminar had participants from various States of India and across continents. The introduction of the Resource person was done by Dr. Yogini Bambardekar, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry. The program was compered by our Chemistry Faculty, Mr. Jack Jose Kurian. The Q&A session was taken up by Ms. Sarika Chhabria Talreja, Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry. The vote of thanks and concluding remarks were given by Ms. Sheela Vasu, Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry.

The speaker, Dr. Sanghamitra Sen started her presentation by defining a polymer and moved on to speak about Lignin, the second most abundant natural polymer (after cellulose) on earth which is primarily obtained from trees. It has a branched and irregular chemical structure composed primarily of phenyl propane (C6-C3) units along with phenolic hydroxyl and methoxy substitutions in varying amounts depending on the botanical source of the material. The aromatic rich structure of lignin makes it a good choice for the replacement of fossil-based polymers. Lignin is used as a polymer either by itself or following functionalization through the hydroxyl groups present in it. A large amount of lignin is annually obtained as a by-product of the pulp and paper industry. Even though this natural polymer offers significant challenges in being utilized (because of their random structure and reactivity), their enormous economic potential (it is a by-product of the pulp and paper industry) when coupled with societal and environmental (renewable source of raw materials and has the potential to generate bioplastics) imperatives are major motivating factors for ensuring their utilization. In this effort following topics were discussed.

- How lignin can be methylated using an eco-friendly and green process to control its reactivity at elevated temperatures. This process generates the scope to further process the chemically modified lignin to generate plastic materials.
- A copper mediated oxidative coupling (Glaser or modified Glaser-Hay reaction) of methylated lignin to create a high molecular weight polymer material which can be further used as a bioplastic.
- A bulk thermal polymerization of alkyne functionalized lignin through Claisen type rearrangement to generate high molecular weight biopolymers with potential to produce lignin-based carbon fibres.

### About the Event:


